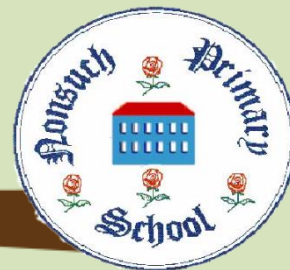

Football

We have had two football matches so far this term played, as with most of our games, on Sutton United's lovely 4G pitch. Our opening league match was against Harris Junior on 2nd October. Each race was over a mile, including the odd hill, through woods and a fair amount of mud. All of our children did well and enjoyed their run.
