Our Football fixtures began this term with our team playing in the Borough 7-a-side tournament on the Tuesday of last week. We are lucky this year that all of our games will be played on Sutton United's 4G pitch, which will avoid boggy, uneven or frozen pitches. On Thursday, a group of ten Y6 children took part in the 'Supremos' training. This is a Sports Leaders scheme that will help the children to run some lunchtime activities for younger children and to have some organisational roles within the school.

#### Anti-Bullying Week

Next week is our Anti-bullying week. During this week we will shine a spotlight on bullying and encourage all children, teachers and parents to take action against bullying throughout the year. The theme is 'All Different, All Equal' with these aims:

This Anti-Bullying Week we want to:

- empower children to celebrate what makes them, and others, unique.
- help children understand how important it is that every child feels valued and included in school, able to be themselves, without fear of bullying.
- encourage parents and carers to work with the school and talk to their children about bullying, difference and equality.
- enable school staff to celebrate what makes us 'all different, all equal' and celebrate difference and equality. Encouraging all of us to take individual and collective action to prevent bullying, creating safe environments where children can be themselves.

The children will spend time during the week reflecting on these aims, sharing our children's antibullying policy and finish on Friday with an interactive play from Firehorse Productions called Just Joshing, delivering the anti-bullying message, in a memorable and fun way, balancing humour with reflection.
